## Perspectives and understandings of disability

The Scottish Journal of Residential Child Care (SJRCC) is inviting submissions for a special themed issue on disability to be published in December 2018. We are seeking abstracts now for papers on any aspect of disability and residential child care - or indeed any aspect of care, or leaving care.

We'd like to hear from academics, from people involved in caregiving, and from young people reflecting on their own experience of care and disability.

The SJRCC publishes two kinds of paper: full-length reports of original research, reviews or conceptual pieces (6,000 words); and shorter accounts of practice, commentaries or reflective pieces (2,000 words). Papers from countries other than Scotland are particularly welcome.
